

Purchasing

1. Members must use the sales contracts and order forms which are provided by Unlimited Network for the sales of Unlimited Network sponsored workshops, services, and products. In addition they must adhere to the Unlimited Network procedures for processing and completion of such contracts and orders.

2. Methods of Payments. Unlimited Network will accept, provided the purchaser has met all eligibility requirements, the following forms of payments for an order:

A Certified Check or Money Order that is made payable to Unlimited Network for the full amount of the order, including applicable sales tax and shipping and handling charges.

A personal check, that complies with the above. However, a personal check must be drawn on the applicant or Member's account and cannot be post dated. Checks must be preprinted with the applicant or Member's name and address. Driver's license number is required.

A Credit Card if the cardholder has completed the credit card authorization section which is on the Member Application and Agreement Form.

A Wire Transfer charge. Call Unlimited Network for wiring information.

3. Fees for Certain Payment Methods.

A. If a product is sold by a Member to a customer using wire transfer, there is an additional processing charge to the Member of \$25.

B. There is a \$29 return check fee processing charge, if a check is returned upon first presentation, even if the check is later honored.

C. Workshop Payment Receipt. The Member completes the line on the Workshop Registration Form that indicates the Member's receipt of money from the customer for a workshop (Step 6 on the Workshop Registration Form.) The Member signs and dates the Workshop Registration Form as an acknowledgment of having received, from the customer, the on the Workshop Registration Form previously mentioned total amount of money. The Customer's copy of the Workshop Registration Form acts as their receipt of having paid to the Member the previously mentioned amount of money.

4. One Registration Form needs to complete for each payment a Customer does.

5. A shipping address can only be a street address. Deliveries cannot be made to a P.O. Box or General Delivery. There are a few exceptions.

6. Shipment is usually by United Parcel Service (UPS) or US Mail. Shipping costs are sometimes included in the price of the product and when not it is detailed on the invoice or packing order.

7. Shipping Time. Normal shipping is ground service.

8. Timely Product and Materials Delivery. Upon clearance of payment, Unlimited Network processes for shipment the products and materials ordered. If an item is temporarily not available (TNA), the purchaser is notified. Should a TNA occur, the item(s) will be shipped as soon as available. This is usually within 14 days of the date the original order and payment were received.

9. Damaged Goods.

The shipping company is responsible for any damage that occurs after it takes physical custody of the goods. A purchaser who receives damaged goods should follow this procedure:

C. Accept delivery.

D. Before the driver leaves, document on the delivery receipt the number of boxes which seem to be damaged.

E. Save the damaged products or boxes for inspection by the shipping agent.

F. Make an appointment with the shipping company to have the damaged goods inspected.

G. File a claim with the shipping company.

10. Product Quality Support. Unlimited Network will replace any product found defective if the customer requests this in writing within 30 days of purchase. There is no assurance that the product will be considered replaceable.

11. Retail Pricing.

Although Unlimited Network provides a *suggested retail price* as a guideline, Members may (even though it is not recommended) charge a different price for Unlimited Network workshops, services, and products. The Member's cost due Unlimited Network for the workshop is the Unlimited Network approved suggested retail price minus the appropriate discounts outlined in the Compensation Plan.

(A suggested retail price is not necessarily the selling price. A Registration Form can have a different suggested retail price than the selling price without changing the regular Registration Form.)

A Member who requests to distribute an Unlimited Network workshop with a different retail price than the Unlimited Network normally suggested retail price, needs to use a Workshop Registration Form that is approved in writing by an Unlimited Network official, when registering people. The new suggested retail price approved for that particular workshop will be the basis for all the payments according to the Compensation Plan.

Special workshops' prices and healing journeys may involve extra ordinary expenses.

Therefore pricing and compensation for these can be individually structured.

Special national and international workshop prices can be affected by the areas' expenses and workshops' pricing and thus prices can be individually structured.

12. Sales Tax.

For purchases made from Unlimited Network, Unlimited Network collects and remits applicable state and local taxes which may be due on the suggested resale price of those products and/or materials which are subject to tax. The applicable rate of tax due is based on the state to which the product and/or material is delivered.

If a Member has obtained his/her own sales tax resale license, and if there is a copy of this resale certificate in Unlimited Network' Home Office, the Member doesn't need to send tax with the order. In that case, the Member is responsible for his/her own sales tax payment to the proper jurisdiction.
